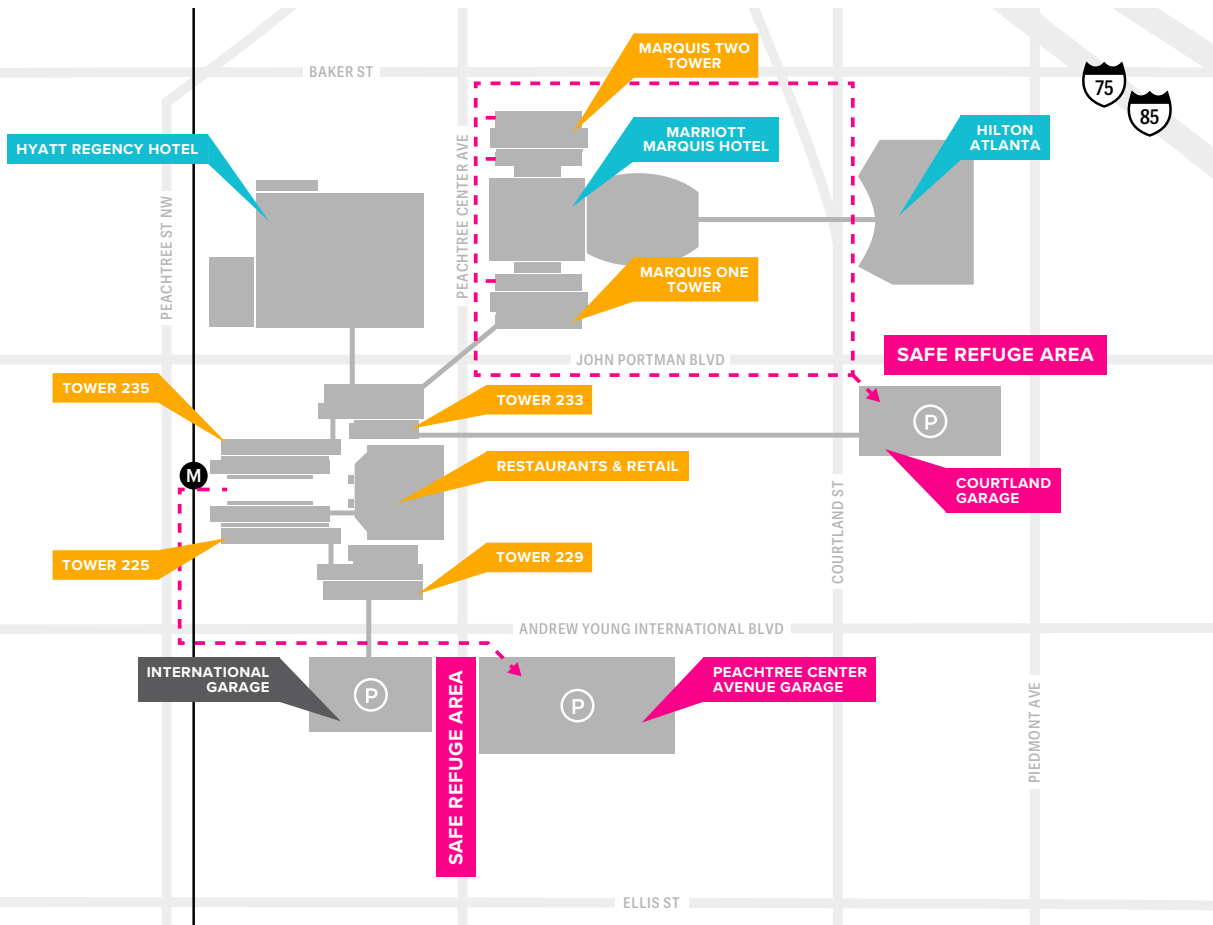


EXTERIOR SAFE REFUGE



IN CASE OF FIRE:

1. Alert others calmly but firmly to evacuate immediately
2. Direct people away from the danger area
3. Close (do not lock) as many doors as possible to contain the fire
4. Evacuate immediately and call 911
5. Move quickly (do not run) to your designated safe refuge area

This map is provided for your convenience. Please print a copy and mark your company's designated safe refuge meeting area and distribute to all employees.

NOTE - In the event of a bomb threat, earthquake or other emergency situations, alternate safe refuge area(s) may be established at that time.

TOWER 235 / TOWER 225 / TOWER 233 / TOWER 229 ESCAPE ROUTE

- After safely exiting the building, proceed to International Blvd.
- Go East on International to Peachtree Center Avenue intersection.
- Your safe refuge area is the Peachtree Center Avenue Garage on the corner of International and Peachtree Center Avenue.

MARQUIS ONE / MARQUIS TWO ESCAPE ROUTE

- After safely exiting the building, proceed to John Portman Blvd.
- Go East on John Portman Blvd. to Courtland Street intersection.
- Your safe refuge area is the Courtland Garage on the corner of John Portman Blvd. and Courtland Street.

Go to the safest area that is up hill and up wind from smoke, fire or harmful liquids. Stay at least 300 feet away from danger and have a secondary path to safety.

If properly trained to do so, use appropriately rated fire extinguisher(s) to fight small fires. Never fight a fire alone and always have a clear exit path away from the fire.
